

## Five Greek Seamen Held in \$1,000 Bond

Five Greek seamen, arrested here and facing deportation on charges of "jumping" their ships while in port, were each held in \$1,000 bonds yesterday for a hearing before an Immigration and Naturalization Service official. No date was set.

Government investigators said the men were: Hostas Dracopoulos, 37, of 1548 McFarland Road, Dormont, who left his ship in July, 1949, at Philadelphia; Nick Spanos, 32, of 719 Valley Street, Oakmont, leaving ship March 13, 1951, at New Orleans; Michael Kontos, 46, of 1611 Memorial Drive, South Hills; his brother, Stephanos Kontos, 29, same address, leaving ship at Baltimore shortly after November 28, 1949, and Adam Farantis, 26, who left his ship last April 14 at Norfolk, Va.
