Picture Bride from Greece Is Spurned By American Hubby

CHICAGO— (U.P.) —Mrs. Georgia Moustakos, 19, a picture bride from Greece, obtained an annulment on the grounds that her husband spurned her because she wasn't as pretty as her photographs.

She said they were married April 18, 1949, immediately after she arrived in the United States from Greece but that Moustakos refused to live with her.
